Tournament Rules

1. Players start with 3,000 in tournament chips.
2. Players will receive 2,000 in tournament chips for an optional \$10 dealer appreciation.
3. All blind levels last 15 minutes. Registration will be open until the end of the 1st break.
4. TDA Rules will be in effect for this event.
5. Each player will pay a \$40 fee. \$20 is the entry fee, \$3 will go towards the promotion fee, and \$17 is the registration fee. 100% of all tournament promotion fees will be paid to the players in the Tournament Leader Board Promotion. The payments will be in the form of tournament entries or tournament entry chips.
6. Players may purchase rebuys during the first four (4) levels when they have 3,000 or less in tournament chips (the only exception being immediately prior to the tournament start, where any player can purchase a rebuy in addition to the dealer appreciation). For each rebuy, the player will spend \$20 and receive 3,000 in tournament chips. In the event a player loses an all-in pot, they may purchase a double rebuy. For \$40, the player may purchase 6,000 in chips.
7. At the end of level four (4), any player, regardless of chip stack, may do a single or double add-on. For a single add-on, players will spend \$20 and receive 3,000 in chips. For a double add-on, players will spend \$40 and receive 6,000 in chips.
